Thinking Skills

Play a game of **One Letter Change-Up (2+ players)**. Think of a short word (4/5 letters). Take turns to come up with as many different words as possible by changing just one letter.

e.g. park – dark – dare – mare – mark – bark – bare – bars – bags – bogs – logs – legs, etc.

Computational Thinking Skills

Hide your favourite toy somewhere in the house. Draw or write a set of instructions (an algorithm) for someone to find it. Be precise with your instructions so that the toy can be found.

Use language such as forward 3 steps, turn left, etc.
