Health and Wellbeing

Create your own fitness circuits at home. Each activity last 60 seconds. How many can you complete?

Here are some examples:

Line jumps; toe touches; star jumps; push ups; bounce a ball; high-knee runs; tuck jumps, etc.

Expressive Arts

Drawing Challenge

This week's drawing challenge is:
Draw a ship that would take you on a fantastic voyage around the world. What sort of things would there be to do onboard?

Thinking Skills

Play a game of ***Traveller's Alphabet (2+ players).***
Player 1 must say a place they are travelling to beginning with the letter A. Player 2, choose a place beginning with the letter B, and so on.

Make it trickier by saying what you'll see there, ***starting with the same letter.***

Computational Thinking Skills

With an adult's help, create a storyboard for your favourite film. Try and keep the storyboard to 6 sections (see attached picture).

Try and include only the most important details in the film, but include enough that it still makes sense.
